Aronson's has been actively taking crucial steps needed to reduce transmission of COVID-19 while maintaining a healthy and safe working environment and efficient operations. Taking care of and protecting our clients, employees and community have been the essential priority.

As the situation continues to evolve, we are following the recommendations of OSHA and the CDC, to ensure we are doing all that is possible for our employees and community to stay protected, while continuing to serve our clients' needs in creating a comfortable and functional jobsite environment.

During these changing times and while we are still adjusting to ways of working in compliance with new requirements and regulations, your help and commitment to these guidelines are indispensable while we serve your needs.

1) Health and Wellness

- a. On the day(s) of our scheduled work, please confirm you are feeling healthy (body temperature is within range (97° - 100.4°), and that you have not come into contact with anyone who is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- b. For the day(s) when work is performed, please keep an attendance log of all workers and visitors during that time and keep the log for at least four weeks in case contact tracing becomes necessary. The log should include the name, phone number, and email address.
- c. The jobsite should be disinfected before we arrive and after we leave.

2) Social Distancing

- a. When possible, prohibit unnecessary visitors to minimize contact; allowing only one trade / subcontractor at a time on a jobsite.
- b. When possible, monitor and enforce personnel physical distance of at least 10'-0".

3) Protective Personal Equipment (PPE)

- a. Wear face coverings at all times while our personnel are on the jobsite.
- b. Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, and when soap is unavailable, use hand sanitizers with at least a 60% alcohol concentration, before our arrival and after we leave the jobsite.

Please note:

Our employees who feel the jobsite is not safe are instructed to contact their supervisor immediately to raise their concerns and get instructions.

If we know someone tested positive for COVID-19, we are required to immediately notify state and local health departments and assist in the contact tracing efforts.
